## **ACT NO. 40, OF SEPTEMBER 1, 2025**

THE COORDINATOR-GENERAL OF AGROCHEMICALS AND SIMILAR PRODUCTS, in the exercise of the powers conferred upon him by Decree No. 11,332, of January 1, 2023, which approves the MAPA Regimental Structure;

Considering what is stated in process no. 21000.008022/2024-73 and in the determination of the Secretariat of Agricultural Defense;

Considering the provisions of art. 12 of Law No. 14,785, of December 27, 2023, which establishes the competence of the Ministry of Agriculture and Livestock for the protocol and distribution of requests for registration of pesticides and similar products;

Considering the need to standardize and centralize the flow of receiving and processing petitions regarding the registration of pesticides and similar products;

Considering the importance of ensuring greater efficiency, transparency, traceability and predictability in the process of analyzing registration requests;

Considering the mandatory use of the Electronic Information System - SEI as the official protocol platform within the scope of MAPA;

Considering OPINION No. 00029/2024/DECOR/CGU/AGU, which provides for the immediate application of Law No. 14,785 of December 27, 2023; resolves:

That from September 15, 2025, companies that intend to apply for registration of pesticides and similar products must file their new registration processes exclusively with the Ministry of Agriculture and Livestock-MAPA, through the Electronic Information System (SEI/MAPA).

MAPA will be responsible for distributing the processes to the competent bodies for analysis, taking into account the technical and operational capacity reported by each institution.

It should be noted that from September 15, 2025, protocols made for new registration requests and post-registrations of new processes, with the National Health Surveillance Agency - Anvisa and the Brazilian Institute of the Environment and Renewable Natural Resources - Ibama, will not be considered for the purposes of organizing the distribution of processes.

It should be noted that the submitted processes will be classified as protected with the restrictions imposed by LAW No. 10,603, of December 17, 2002.

After the implementation of the Unified Electronic Information, Petition and Assessment System (SISPA), a normative act will establish the flow for submitting process requests.
